This module augments Views by allowing bulk operations to be executed on the displayed rows. It does so by showing a checkbox in front of each node, and adding a select box containing operations that can be applied. Drupal Core or Rules actions can be used.

- [Rules](#) can be used to create custom actions to use with Views Bulk Operations. It can also be used to call bulk operation views programmatically.
- [Improved Admin](#) provides, well, improved admin pages using VBO.
- [Total Control](#) is an administrator dashboard that uses VBO.
- [Views Send](#) allows sending mass emails using VBO.
- [VBO Context menu](#) provides a context menu for VBO, where all operations available to the VBO show up on right click.
- Views Block in [Views Hacks](#) exposes blocks as Views objects that can be administered using a dedicated VBO.
- [Language assignment](#) provides an action to change a nodes' language.

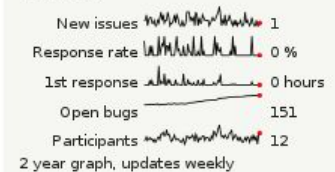

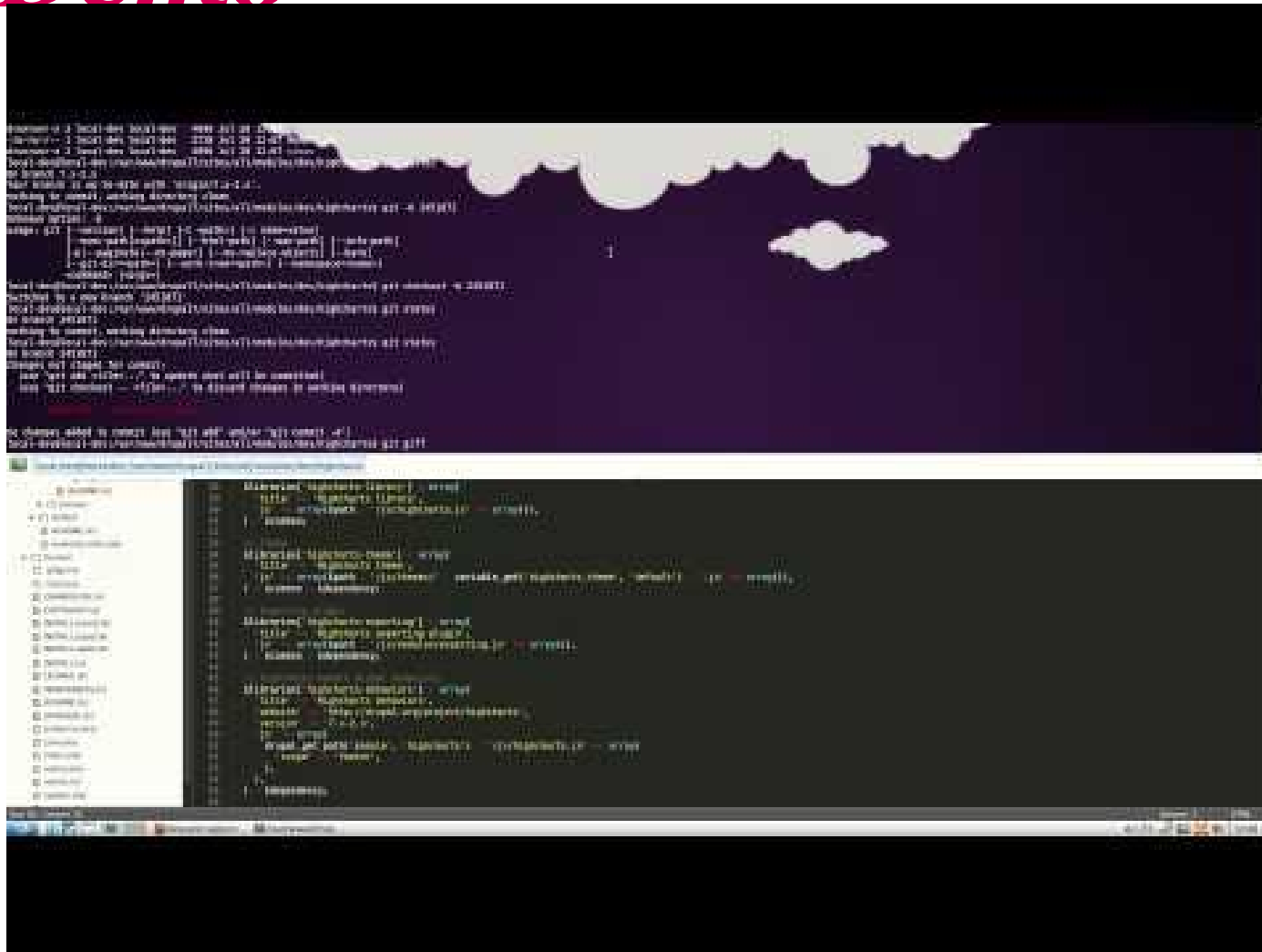

If the issue has no patch

1. Clone the project
 - a. `git clone --branch [branch] [repository]`
 - b. `git clone --branch 8.x-1.x https://git.drupal.org/project/paragraphs.git`
2. Create a branch to work on
 - a. `git checkout -b [issue ID]-[comment ID]`
 - b. `git checkout -b 2705045-12`
3. Make the required changes
4. Create the patch
 - a. `git diff [original branch] > description-[issue ID]-[comment ID].patch`

If the issue has a patch

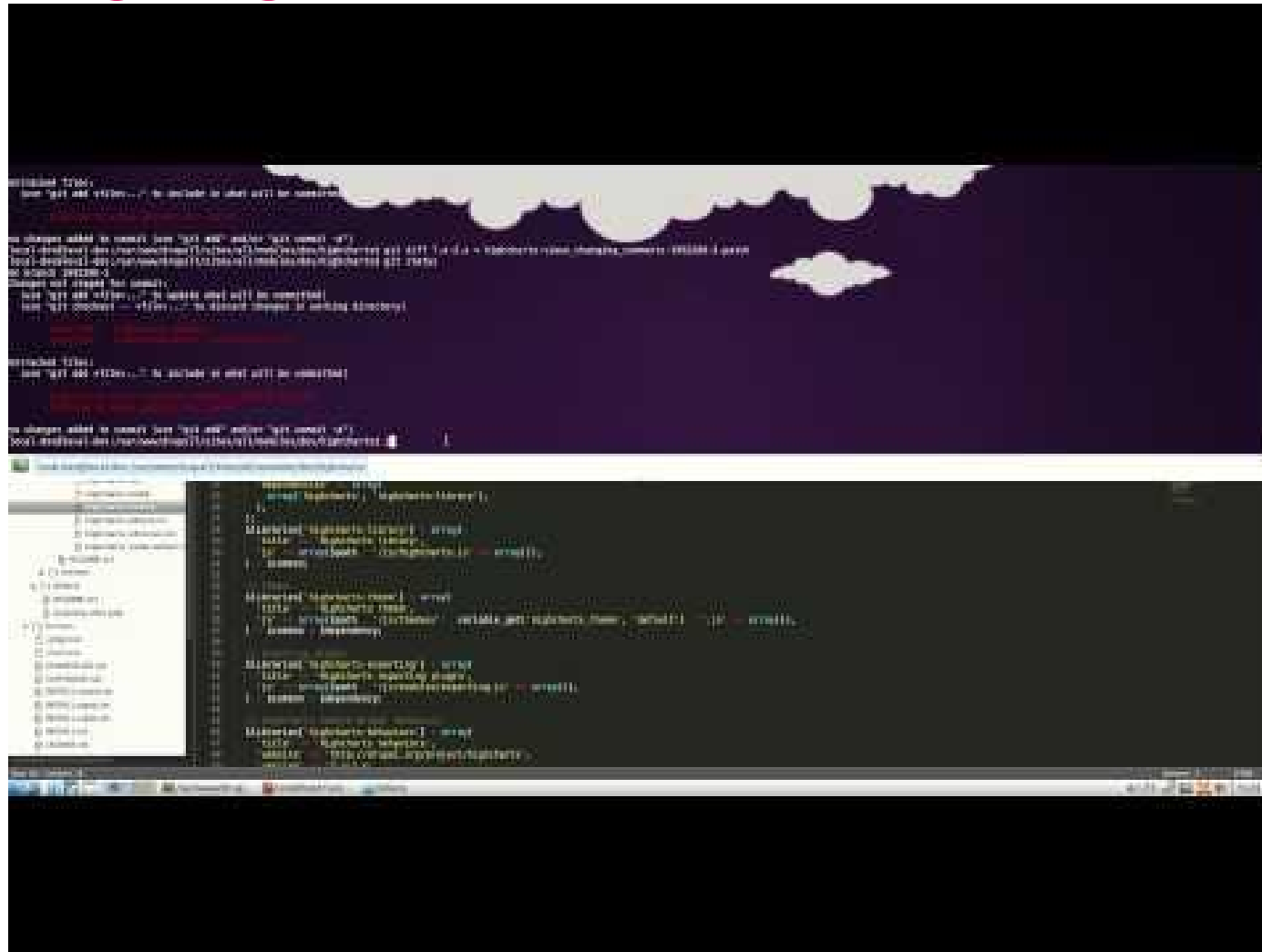
1. Clone the project
 - a. `git clone --branch [branch] [repository]`
 - b. `git clone --branch 8.x-1.x https://git.drupal.org/project/paragraphs.git`
2. Create a branch to work on and apply the patch
 - a. `git checkout -b [issue ID]-[comment ID]`
 - b. `wget [path-to-patch]; git apply file.patch`
 - c. `git checkout -b 2705045-12`
3. Make the required changes
4. Create the patch
 - a. `git diff [original branch] > description-[issue ID]-[comment ID].patch`

If the issue has a patch

5. Create interdiff between patches

```
interdiff old.patch new.patch > interdiff-[Issue ID]-[Old  
Comment ID]-[New Comment ID].txt
```
